NOTICE OF INTERIM CHILDREN'S CRISIS RESPONSE SYSTEM PLAN

The following is a list of options to help a child facing a behavioral health emergency receive the support they need.

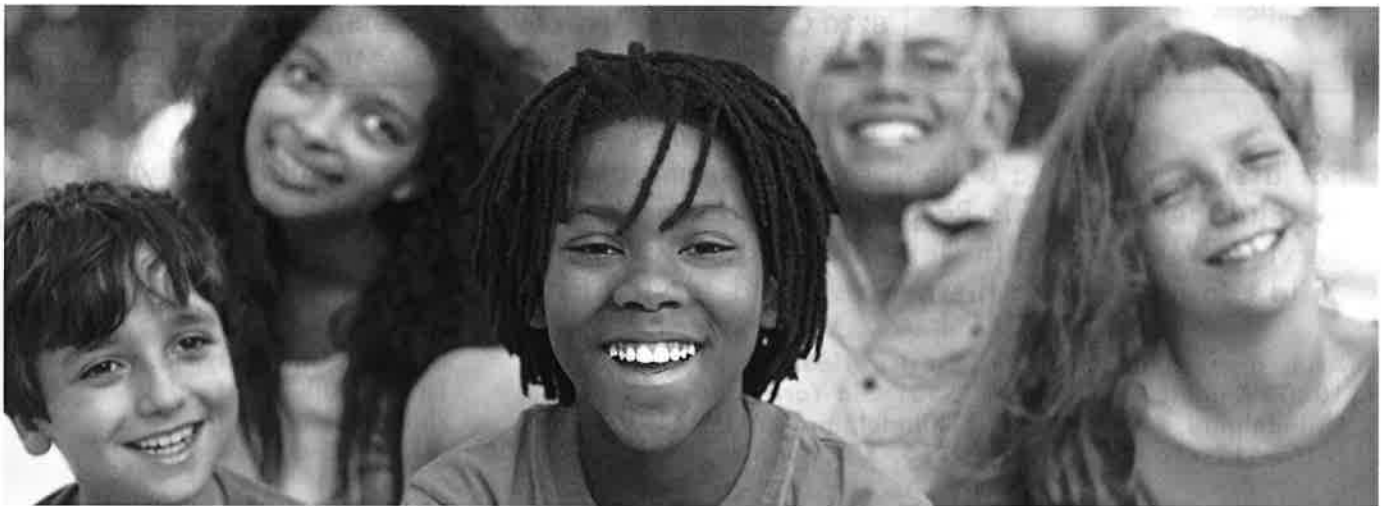
